Please look at our code of conduct.

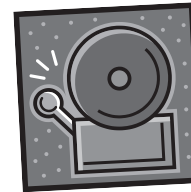
These are expectations that we believe will make a supportive and safe learning environment for your child. Students who obey the code of conduct will have opportunities to earn some great rewards.

If the need should arise, we may ask you to sit in with your child's class so you can better understand the behavior needed to allow each child to learn to know and love the Lord



Safety Policies

For your child's safety, we ask that you take them to their classes and drop them off. We also ask that you come and pick them up at the end of class. We want to make sure that your child does not have a chance to wander outside or get in trouble in the hallways. Calvary is too large a facility for the children's teachers to police all this area.



We want to keep your child safe!

Children will not be released until you come for them. They may meet you at the bottom of the stairs in the education building but please come to their class to pick them up from Children's church each Sunday morning. Children should not roam the halls unaccompanied during the worship service. Ushers or church security

will escort them to you during the service if they are found doing this.



Emergency Notice

Be sure you know your contact number!

All families with children from birth to grade 3 have an emergency number assigned. If there is a need for you while your child is in the nursery or children's church, we will post this number on the screen in the sanctuary. Please come to the nursery area for contact. This may also be used in the case of an extreme disciplinary problem. If you have a question about your number please see Faye Williams or Jenice Pearson
