SCARY WORDS OF THE BIBLE



Registration is now open for a new Halloween inspired small group study where we will explore some of the scariest words in the Bible! What does it actually mean when Jesus tells Peter to "Get behind me Satan." Or what was Jesus talking about when he spoke of "hell" where there's weeping and gnashing of teeth? Have you ever wondered what the book of Revelation means when it describes the "apocalypse?"

In this small group we will attempt to remove the mysterious and scary elements from these Biblical concepts. You will learn where these words and concepts came from and how they've changed from the time of Jesus to our current day understandings.

Week 2: Devil - Satan - Adversary

Week 3: Apocalypse - Revelation - Tribulation


FIFTH SUNDAY SERMON– WHAT DO YOU WANT TO KNOW?
