The Act of Meekness

'But as for you, man of God, shun all this; pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance, gentleness (meekness). '

1 Timothy 6:11

It's good for us to see the virtues that God gives us as people who are flawed, people who make mistakes, and people who sin. And all of us have walked from a life that, at times, has been contrary to God. When I think about these particular verses, let's remind ourselves, particularly in verse 11. Oh, people, flee these things. And you probably ask, well, flee from what? Paul talks about the strife, the envy, the railings, the perverse disputing of men who suppress the truth.

The godly things are not envy and strife, disputes, but the godly things are righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, and gentleness, of which I will call meekness. And for us, the reality is that we're all striving to be more like God as we walk with Jesus. And we will not always get it right. I haven't always gotten it right. But that pursuit of righteousness is the pursuit of godliness. And in so many ways, these virtues are rooted in our faith. Faith produces righteousness. It produces godliness. It produces love. It produces patience. It produces meekness. Embodying meekness is not to say that it's a devaluing of oneself, but it's a gentleness. It's a proper place of introspection and taking stock of who we are. Meekness is not aggressive in its motives.

It's not violent in its pursuits. It's a gentleness that comes with meekness, and all these things embody who Jesus is. Jesus is a meek God. Meekness is not a weakness. Meekness is a virtue, and God is present and powerful, and righteous, and meek at the same time. Our faith in so many ways is the anchor by which we follow all these things. Our pursuit of righteousness is exactly that. We want to reflect God's character in our lives. Godliness flows out of our desire to be more likened to what God has purposed for us to be as God's image bearers.
