Divine Hope in All Circumstances by Rev. Judson Dunlap

So I stopped by Duke's campus two nights ago on the way home from a United Methodist clergy meeting to look up something in the library of the Freeman Center for Jewish Life, Duke's Jewish student union. While there I beheld a devotional table set up with prayers for peace and security for Israel, candles, and poems. One post-WWII prayer that had circulated in 1948 at the time of modern Israel's independence movement read, "Sovereign of the universe, accept in lovingkindness and favor our prayers for the State of Israel...Spread over Israel and all the world Your shelter of peace..." ending with Isaiah 2.4's hopeful vision, "Nation shall not lift up sword against nation; neither shall they learn war anymore." My heart joined in this prayer for world peace and then sank in sadness as I saw a prayer list of 152 names of Jews who had been taken hostage in the Oct. 7, 2023 attacks by Hamas on Israel's soil.

My heart began thinking about what those Jewish hostages were experiencing – the horror of being held by those who wish to end their existence on this earth and to terrorize them along that dreadful way. I asked myself, "What could possibly be sustaining them and giving them hope? What could sustain anyone – Jew, Christian, or Muslim -- in that situation?" Before deploying overseas to combat zones in the middle east in 2019 as a Navy chaplain, I underwent SERE training (Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape) that prepared me how to handle the possibility of being taken as a POW – how to interact with my captors, how to honor my country and not betray the Constitution, and mostly how to survive. I thought then as I do now: Spiritual preparation through prayer and biblical closeness to God, my Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer was the answer. Through daily conversation with God via God's holy Word, we can be strengthened and ready for whatever may befall us.

Today's Daily Office of prayer from *The Book of Common Prayer* provides fitting words from Psalm 43, "Vindicate me, O God, and defend my cause against an ungodly people; from those who are deceitful and unjust, deliver me! For you are the God in whom I take refuge...O send your light and your truth; let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy hill and to your dwelling. Then I will go to the altar of God, to God my exceeding joy...Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my help and my God."

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Music Ministry Update


How about getting to sing some Christmas music in November?
