We are familiar with the term, "the dog days of summer." It's a specific time frame from July 3rd to August 11th when we typically have the hottest days of the year. It's a time frame of forty days and originally dates back to ancient Greek and Roman times with the time frame being more of a month from July 24th to August 24th.

For some, summertime means longer days and a slower pace of life. It's a great time as to be reflective, to spend time in nature soaking up God's creation, and for us at Walnut Grove in the summer of 2023 to enjoy the gift of the Psalms as we have over these past few weeks. We're dedicating six weeks to our summer sermon series, "Summer in the Psalms."

With this gift of poetic prayer, we find the Psalms give us language to pray when we don't know how to pray. We receive this gift of words to convey what we're thinking or feeling with a whole host and range in emotions.

Dr. Howell in his book, "The Beautiful Work of Learning to Pray," shares:

The psalms are brutally honest, and they can help us know ourselves honestly, and to pray honestly before God. And yet the Psalms, and the rest of the Bible, stretch us beyond the kind of praying that forever gets stuck into "me and my concerns." The Bible lures us out of our own small world and into God's huge world. We begin to know God's worries, to feel God's pain for people beyond our small circle."

I invite us to live into the rhythm of the slowness we find in these dog days of summer. Meditate on God's scripture with the pace that causes you to experience the living water like a faucet that is barely dripping, focusing on one drop at a time. This Sunday we will be looking at Psalm 121 in worship. Find a psalm that speaks to your heart and mind. May God continue to speak to us in this prayer poetry together.
