

blessing to hunker down with the family and Pastor Will last year and make recordings to post so that we could in some sense be "together," still there is nothing like being able to gather with God's people in worship. I think that I will never take that privilege for granted again, especially at Christmas time.

The Annual Congregational Meeting will take place on Sunday, February 11, 2024 at 12:30pm in the sanctuary.







## **Adult Education**

Beginning in the upcoming 2024 Winter Term, the Adult Sunday School class will study a new lesson series by Dr. Derek Thomas. This series will look at the lives of those individuals from both the Old and New Testament who trusted God in difficult circumstances – often from the prison cell. This class, led by Kevin Selkregg, will have discussions focused around the feature video by Dr. Thomas.

From Genesis to Revelation, there is no shortage of God's people who have found themselves imprisoned. They have been thrown into dark dungeons, locked behind closed doors, and exiled to remote lands. For each one of these people, there are lessons to be learned that can be applied to any trying circumstance. Dr. Derek Thomas journeys through the whole of Scripture to draw out these lessons to strengthen our faith in whatever circumstances we might find ourselves. The AE committee invites all congregants to join us in this important series to be held in Waith Hall at 9:45.
