- 1 With Jesus your Weakness may be your greatest strength.
- 2 With Jesus Weakness has a purpose.

What are weaknesses?

- Insults
- Hardships
- Persecutions
- Difficulties
- 3 With Jesus we see through our weaknesses that our real strength comes from Him.

Action Steps:

- Trust God with your weaknesses.
- Let God work in and through your weaknesses.
- Live in God's sufficient grace to find power in times of weakness.
- Look to help others in their weakness by praying for them and pointing them to God's sufficient grace.

storylines prompt:

Identify a personal weakness you have in your life right now. Ask God' for discernment in how He wants to work in you and through in this weakness. What steps can you take to step into the grace of God as you look to find power in your weakness.

The Big Idea:

 How does focusing on God's perspective help you in trusting Him?.
- How can you help another believer who is struggling trusting God with their weakness? What would share with a non-believer how God can help them with their weaknesses?
