Elisha's faith steps took him from the life of a farmer to that of a prophet. This week let's explore some of the stories from Elisha's life to see what we can learn and apply.

Monday | 2 Kings 2:1-14

What request did Elisha make? What was he really asking for?
When you ask for God to bless you, what are you hoping he will do?
Why did Elisha strike the water?

Tuesday | 2 Kings 4:1-7

When have you faced an impossible situation? What did you do?
Where in your story do you need to "collect jars and pour oil"?
What might that look like?

Wednesday | 2 Kings 4:8-37

How did the couple show hospitality?
What seemingly hopeless situation are you facing? (Is it really hopeless?)
What role does prayer play in your story?

Thursday | 2 Kings 5:1-19

How does Naaman's story give you encouragement?
Has God ever asked you to do something that didn't make sense to you?
What is often the result of incomplete obedience?

Friday | 2 Kings 6:8-23

Do you ever consider how much is going on spiritually that we can't see?
Why was there no need to fear?
How does faith help us see what others cannot?

Weekend | 2 Kings 8:1-6

Have you ever done what was right only to end up in a predicament?
How did God solve the woman's problem (and honor her obedience)?
How have you seen God work out the circumstances of your life?
