August 28 Pray that the leaders of your church will "make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification." Ask the Lord to increase your unified prayers for revival (Romans 14:19).

August 29 Pray for the movement of prayer for revival and awakening to grow exponentially in our nation, so that believers will pray in agreement in Jesus' name, knowing that He promises to be present with them (Matthew 18:19-20).

August 30 Pray that believers in Christ will unite in prayer for spiritual awakening, and my unifying in faith will attain "the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." As witnesses to God's saving grace available to all (Ephesians 4:13).

August 31 Pray that as the church unites in prayer with hope for revival, we will experience God's great mercy in the healing and restoration of our land (2 Chronicles 7:14).

September 1 Rejoice with Hannah that God hears and answers our prayers, and that we can "delight in [His] deliverance." Reflect on your many answered prayers-especially the ones that seemed impossible-and thank God for His faithfulness (1 Samuel 2:1).

September 2 Declare, as Hannah did, "There is no one holy like the Lord; there is no one besides you; there is no Rock like our God." Pray for the next generation to embrace the holiness of God as the guiding truth in their lives (1 Samuel 2:2).

September 3 Hannah acknowledged, "The Lord brings death and makes alive; he brings down to the grave and raises up." Pray for young people to know the power of God, who gives life and breathes hope into their generation. Ask God to raise them up in radical obedience (1 Samuel 2:6).

OPEN DOORS' LOCAL PARTNERS

August 28 Pray for our local partners as they cultivate strong leaders for churches of believers from a Muslim background who will disciple new believers.

August 29 As soon as Open Doors partners are in contact with a new believer, they attempt to connect them to a local (underground) church. The work is risky. Pray for guidance for our partners.

August 30 Our staff in the Middle East needs your prayers. When they visit secret believers, they often must travel to isolated and often risky areas. Pray the Lord will "blind" the eyes of persecutors.

August 31 Pray for stamina for our local partners. Ask God to revive them when they're weary and strengthen them when they're weak. Pray especially for good physical and emotional health.

MEN IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA

September 1 Pray with Jemal*, and Ethiopian believer whose successful woodworking and steel businesses were destroyed in Islamic extremist mob attacks. "Pray for [Christians to regain] influence in our community," he says.

September 2 Where Jemal lives, Muslims have isolated the Christians. It's difficult, even dangerous, for children to go to school by themselves. He asks us to pray: "In every place I go, pray for boldness."

September 3 Pray that God will strengthen Pastor Zumia* in Nigeria. He is walking daily with his wife through the trauma she suffered in military captivity.
