Collective Prayer

At last week's Wednesday night's Bible Study Bro. Dean spoke to us about why we should pray "collectively" or as a church body. We then spent time praying collectively for our children/grandchildren as a follow up to Sunday's sermon from Ephesians 6:1-4.

- Praying collectively gives added power to our prayers.
- Praying collectively increases our joy in the Lord
- Praying collectively gives greater glory to God
- Praying collectively makes our ministry more fruitful
- We see the collective work of God when praying collectively
- There's "unity" in praying collectively
- By praying collectively, we grow closer together
- We know Jesus more when we are praying collectively

One way we can pray is to use **ACTS** as a guide.

A: adoration to God

"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised." Psalm 45:3

C: confession

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins." 1 John 1:9

T: thanksgiving

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good." Psalm 136:1

S: supplication - a request or petition

"Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness...have mercy on me and hear my prayer." Psalm 4:1
