Arizona Reservation Ministries, Greetings!

We have had another amazing year. God is good! Thank you all for your prayers and support! As many are aware, we have had terrible flooding here at Globe and on the Reservation. Dozens of homes were destroyed. In Globe, three people were swept away and lost their lives in the storm. Please pray for their families and loved ones. I can't imagine the heartbreak. Our little Kubota tractor ran for nearly two weeks straight, removing mud and debris from flooded homes, and grading driveways along the canyons into which flood waters pushed dirt and mud and cut ruts. "Thank you" to Justin and Theresa Lawrence for all the hours helping our neighbors! ARM had some damage from the floods as well. Eighty tons of boulders that protect our bridge were washed away. Only one Gabion basket was destroyed. The replacement rock is being placed in those baskets this time. Thanks to those that contributed to the bridge repair fund!

Food and other critically needed items continue with provisions coming from around the country. We are praying for other churches to adopt a month and collect nonperishable items so we can have a more consistent supply to take care of this tremendous need. Clothing and gently used furniture, on the other hand, is overwhelming our limited storage right now. Our Needs List online specifies what we need at any given time and is updated regularly. We want to thank those who have given so generously this past year!

Amid all the storm chaos, Pastor Chopper's home is under construction. We have nearly completed the exterior shell and have started with interior rough electric and plumbing. We will need work teams to help complete this project and the funds to finish the interior. Please keep this great need in your prayers.

We thank God that we'll be able to end the year with all bills paid. With the provision of a significant gift, we will also have our property loan paid in full. Praise God! This will allow us to use those funds toward hiring much-needed staff. Please pray for us to have wisdom in the process of filling positions here. We have a great team. Your prayers in this matter are very important to us.

Our Native Staff continue to minister in mighty ways. Pros and Roxie have continued the youth Basketball program with the purpose of exposing the kids to the Gospel of Christ and getting them involved in serving their community. Vincent continues filling the pulpit at the American Indian Church, is still doing funerals on a frequent basis and now leading a Bible Study at a Tribal Elder facility. Vermaleen continues to run the children's ministry as well as distributing food and more and serving in many ways at the AIC. Mike continues to serve alongside our work teams and me with construction and whatever else we need him to assist with. Tori, Adreanna, and Aiden are helping with children's ministries when able. Macaiah has been leading the construction on Chopper's home when not working as a Fire Fighter for the San Carlos Fire Department! Jon, Linda and Diana and I keep plugging in where needed. Thank you all for helping to make this possible.

Thank you for praying and for doing what God speaks to your heart to do; whatever that may be. We know that without you, none of what we get to do here for the Kingdom would be possible.
