Dale and I have been blessed to serve on the mission field for nearly 35 years! The adventures have been incredible, the stories of God’s miracles innumerable. One thing we’ve noticed, is that when something amazing is about to happen for the Kingdom, the attacks of Satan intensify. I think it looks like one of those seasons is upon us. We were able to purchase a new stove/grill for the dorm where our visiting teams reside. It’s huge and heavy. With the assistance of strong guys from 1st Christian Church in Yuma, the old one was moved and the new one put into place. Dale lifted it to make it level and now has some significant back pains. (In addition to his other pains.) Pros is looking at eye surgery. Space limits listing all that’s been going on, but your prayers for each of us are deeply treasured. As always, we thank you for those prayers. I’m also humbled that the LORD has provided a way for us to come into His throne room and lift our concerns to Him.

The events of the past month that have allowed us to travel to share what God is doing through ARM on the San Carlos Apache Reservation have been a big blessing! It is always encouraging to hear others begin to understand what nearby neighbors must endure, and become concerned about how they can help. I was also able to visit via facetime with a church in California who hadn’t heard of us before, and Northside Christian Church in New Albany, IN. That church recorded our meeting and created a brief video they’ll be sharing with their members later this month. We’re often asked how people find out about us. God does the orchestrating.

The teams from Second Church of Christ, Danville, IL and First Christian Church, Yuma, AZ were able to accomplish much during their visits with us! Friends from Yuma also invited guests from Anaheim, CA to join them, allowing them to see first-hand what this ministry is all about. Each group that visits us (as well as others!) join in a Prayer Journey of the San Carlos Apache Reservation. By traveling and sharing about the Reservation early in their visits, their reasons for serving with us become better understood. It is always our prayer that these visitors return home with a greater desire to continue to pray for all of us.

Because our Illinois friends were here for a week, they also planned the game and the craft for our Children's Ministries, being popular visitors to the children and teens of our weekly visits. The parsonage for the Morgan family looks beautiful. Trim work and painting are complete, and more work has been done on the inside, too. In addition, work was done at our offices-painting, organizing, etc. and the dorm as they organized the pantry of donated food, painted, cleaned, and more. The cracked and old beams on our bridge have been replaced. That, too, was a huge job that we're thankful to have completed! One day, we were personally blessed by the labors of the Yuma team as they moved a huge amount of dirt, retaining wall block that had slid down the hill during the floods, and so much more at our home. We wouldn't ask for assistance with our own needs, but their willingness to help us was a great encouragement!



Our RV has been to the dealer in Phoenix, getting the maintenance and repairs all taken care of. Rest assured, we would ALL love to be able to have it serving full-time in our Children's Ministries. We continue to pray for the Lord to provide someone to serve as the driver and as a children's minister! Already more than 100 children participate in this ministry on a weekly basis, simply sitting on carpet squares on top of a tarp outside each afternoon. Although we want an RV driver, our greatest concern is for the faithful character of this Christ-follower. We don't know who it is, yet...but God does. Please join us in praying for patience as we wait, and for God to provide His servant(s) soon.

We continue to thank you for praying for our family! Our four children now have families of their own and all have busy and productive schedules. Jacque and Wade live 1 ½ hours north of us. 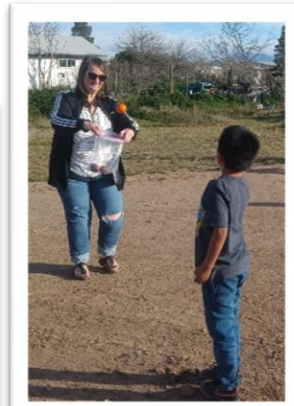
