



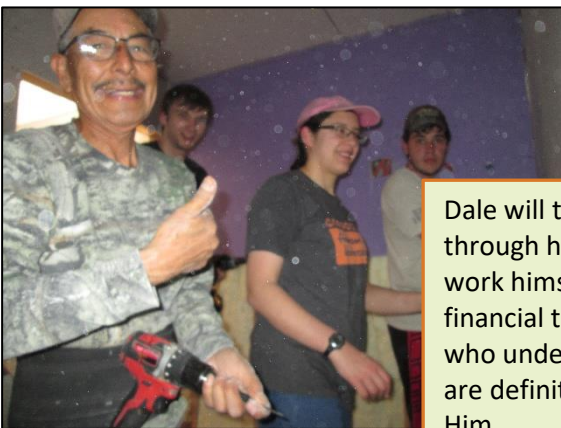
Greetings! From

This past month has held great reminders that the “Church” is not a building, but instead remains those who fill it, or serve in the Name of Jesus Christ. Those people: each of you, those of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and this ministry, are precious to Him! It was bittersweet to host a barbecue in our home with over 20 team members and their families to let our intern, Noah, know how much we appreciated all he did with us while serving from January until May. There’s a little boy in Labumba named Noah, too. We learned to call them, “Big Noah” and “Little Noah.” Little Noah asked how Big Noah was doing just yesterday. He is missed!

Those teams who came March-May to serve with us accomplished so much. Their extra ARMs helped us accomplish so much: replacing the planks on our bridge, cleaning up the trail that runs up our hill, bringing down the prayer benches for repairs, completing drywall and painting projects at the parsonage, removing a large amount of dirt, replacing and leveling the floor at Micah and Monica’s home, leading games and crafts for more than 120 children each week, and sharing meals, card games, prayers, and laughter with our team. Every bit of it meant a great deal to us. As June began, the two teams on the calendar for this month had to reschedule. One will arrive in August instead, while the other celebrates a new job opportunity elsewhere. We’re excited to know that we’ll get to see them one day, too! In the meantime, all the construction projects, children’s ministry activities, and day-to-day work are being accomplished this month by “just” our team through the strength of Jesus Christ. The days are very hot, but we know your prayers and support continue. Words can’t express how much that means to us! Truly, the “Church,” the Body of Christ, continues. For that we are humbled and grateful.

We’re looking forward to a team from Texas and one from Oregon joining us in July! Already, we’re receiving inquiries about being added to our 2027 Short-term Ministry Calendar!



Dale will turn 70 in August! I’m incredibly thankful that God continues to serve through him overseeing the construction tasks, including doing a great deal of the work himself, ordering supplies, traveling to the valley to pick up materials, all the financial tasks, and more. We’re asking for you to join us in praying for a man of God who understands and can do all phases of construction to join this team soon. We are definitely most focused on the person God already sees, whose heart is knit to Him.

We also need someone who can serve through our Children’s Ministries in submission to Vermaleen, our Children’s Minister. Because we continue to gather with the children four afternoons each week although temperatures exceed 100 degrees, it’s tempting for the children to stay in their cooler homes, so less are attending right now. While sitting on the tarp, but not on a carpet square, I was reminded just how hot the concrete gets where we begin the visits with lessons right now on the Beatitudes. We need your prayers. Please pray for God to send His servants for these critical positions. Until He does, we are grateful to be able to serve Him in these tasks. Of most importance is the faith and faithfulness of these future ARM team members. We thank God for the 13 He has already called to serve together! Each one has many responsibilities. It's been another season of challenges for our team. Dale's pains continue. In fact, they've worsened. He's due to have an epidural this Monday. Jon's pains continue. Along with his leg and back pains from a past injury, he also has a pacemaker. He gets a lot accomplished in our offices, but being out in the heat is extra challenging for him. Pros underwent eye surgery. Vincent had his heart ablation, with a follow-up coming soon. One of those dear residents at the Tribe's Assisted Living Facility had a stroke but is finally back and doing well. Our grand daughter had knee surgery and is looking at another surgery on the 23rd. We thank God that we live where medical care is possible. We simply ask that you would pray for the right doctors, etc., and for strength for each of us. Thank you.

The sounds outside our offices are loud, and VERY welcoming! County officials and many others have now coordinated the tasks for mitigation following our extensive flooding this past fall. Our bridge to access our offices is 20 feet above the creek bed. Most of the year, that creek runs dry. The water flowed off the mountains above us, and violently down that creek. There was debris on the bottom of our 20-foot-high bridge! They're removing the silt, adding boulders, and covering them with concrete on the "high" side of the bridge where the public road was in jeopardy. They have 220 days to complete the project in order to receive funding. It's a HUGE job and exciting and encouraging to watch!

This is the month when we're praying hard for friends to deliver or order school supplies to be delivered to our offices! This early collection season, the majority of our bins are still empty. Please pray for many to help with this huge project so that as the students return to the classrooms the end of July, they'll have the supplies they need to feel confident, prepared, and ready to learn.

MUCH is unfolding within our team! Macaiah has added a very important role to his list as husband, father of five, Firefighter and construction worker with ARM. He's now preaching! Please pray for him as he stands boldly against the evil one in this new position. Pros and Roxie took 24 to California for some beach time and tournaments. Many of the teens had just celebrated their high school graduations, including both Aiden and Audrey! While there, one of the young men asked to be baptized, creating both a memorable moment for them all, and an eternity-altering decision for him. Pray for the others who are considering such a decision as well.

Vincent and Vermaleen are already holding meetings in preparation for leading a team of Apache Christians planning to serve elsewhere on the planet in 2027!



What a wonderful month of celebrations! Andi and Anissa both graduated from Globe High School-Andi, *summa cum laude* and Anissa, *magna cum laude*! Edward graduated from eighth grade. And, both Tommy and Nolan graduated from kindergarten! Jon's family will have FOUR Freshmen in the fall! Andi heads to GCU, both Jasmine and Morgan (through dual enrollment with the high school) plan to attend the nearby community college, and Edward will be in his first year of high school. We'll be celebrating the arrival of our first great grandbaby soon as Jacque and Wade become his grandparents. Please pray for the health of both "Mommy Megan" and "Baby Arlo." We thoroughly enjoyed having Jenna here for the graduations! She was also able to take care of some technical problems I was having with the ARM website and enjoy some bonding time over the raised bed gardens Dale has planted.
