“What *is* the Bible? We ask this question because before we can understand what the Bible says, we need to understand what it is. While the Bible is written with words like any other book, the Bible is not like any other book. After all, it’s God’s Word.

In looking at a book – you want to know who the author is – that determines how you approach the book. We will summarize the Bible’s authorship this way: the Bible is the triune God’s speech written through the agency of human authors.

In the very beginning we meet God as a speaking God – Genesis 1; He speaks truth, and He is faithful to his word. God also speaks words for us to read – Psalm 19 –the law, the statutes, the precepts, the commands, the decrees. The Bible reflects who God is – his perfection, purity, truthfulness, his inestimable worth.”
