## *From the* **PASTOR**—

### **Greetings in the Name of our Lord, Jesus Christ!**

Can I ask you a favor?

I hope I can because I believe you want the same things as I do for Tabor Church - for us to love God, love others and live out our commission from Jesus to go and make disciples. Unfortunately there is an area of disciples that are not well represented at Tabor Church - young families. But God is great and God has heard our prayers and God has been working on the hearts of the young moms and dads and other young adults that are already at Tabor Church with a desire and a passion to serve and do ministry and reach out to our community of other young families! Hallelujah! Praise the Lord! Thank You Jesus!!!

Again - can I ask you a favor? And I know I can because I know - that you know - that in the big picture - it's not about you or me - it's all about our Heavenly Father - and it's all about those who don't know Jesus yet. And for that reason I want to thank you because I know that some of the music styles that we have been introducing into worship may not be your favorite style. But again you have been gracious because you know it's not about us - it's about God and those who don't know him yet. It is our hope and prayer that some of the new music styles that we are introducing will resonate with new disciples at Tabor Church.

Which brings me to my big "favor" - and if you want to "give me this" as an early Christmas gift then I sure would appreciate it and would not ask for another thing for a long time! In order to facilitate a new awesome Holy Spirit-led children's ministry this September 8, 2024 - we are looking to change our time of worship from 9:00A.M. to 10:00A.M. and

have our Sunday School time at 9:00A.M. We will still have our special fellowship time after worship as we do now if you can stay after. I pray that this time change is not a hardship for you. I really do not want to cause you or anyone any inconvenience. But this is a great and unique opportunity that I believe God is doing and I want to be faithful in following God's lead - we pray about this all the time!

And it is worth mentioning as a friendly and loving reminder - that this new schedule would actually be closer to the schedule that Tabor had before COVID. Our present 9:00A.M. worship time was just a time randomly picked as COVID happened - 9:00A.M. was arbitrarily chosen to begin the COVID online worship service as everything was shut down. And as everything slowly opened (and closed and reopened) we just kept the 9:00A.M. time to have some consistency during a very stressful time of reopening. But now, through much prayer, discernment and conversations with others - I believe this September 8, 2024 is the time God is wanting to take Tabor to a new phase with an intentional, concentrated and focused effort in making disciples of all ages, including the young ones!

Isaiah 43:19 "Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert". Matthew 18:3-6 "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, but whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea". Matthew 19:14 Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do

not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven".

I understand that many "church experts" warn against changing worship times because as we all know - we hate change! We are people of habit - don't make any changes to my "normal" world! But in "jesting" - perhaps that is what the dinosaurs were saying (if they could talk but you get the idea) and of course we don't want to end up like the dinosaurs. We know everything changes - and many things are good changes - how about your big screen high definition TV, how about having air conditioning in your house, how about the automatic transmission and power brakes and steering in your car? All good changes - that in time - once we adjusted to them - then we embraced the blessing that they were - and that is my hope and prayer for the time change of worship to 10:00A.M. this September 8, 2024.

I understand the "church experts" might be right about other churches but I also understand the "church experts" don't know Tabor Church. I know Tabor Church is different. I know Tabor Church loves God, loves their church and their community. I know Tabor Church loves children and is willing to do whatever it takes to have children come to our church. And I am not just saying this as a "positive coach chat". We lived this and you proved this! You are different in the best way possible! To be honest with you - I would have given up when we were going through COVID. But you showed me Tabor Church was different in a great and Godly way! You showed me how God was at work in us and through us and this has inspired me every day! I want to be involved with you and what the Holy Spirit is doing at Tabor Church!

And lastly, here is something to consider. And let me preface this with "that the sky is not falling", God is on the throne and God is in control, and God loves and cares about you and Tabor Church, Amen! But something we all need to be aware of is the average age of most of our members at Tabor Church. How do the members of Tabor Church look in 5 years, 10 years? Who is able to serve in the same way as we are now functioning? Many of our church people have and are experiencing some serious health issues. And we praise God that He has been with us through all our health challenges. But we also need to be "good stewards" of what God has entrusted us with.

"God calls us to be "wise" and to have a vision - without it we will perish.

Thank you for taking the time to read all of this - as it is my joy to share my heart with you and humbly ask you to do this favor - to embrace our new worship time starting at 10:00A.M. on Sunday, September 8, 2024.

### **RALLY DAY 2024 SCHEDULE**

Rally Day is Sunday, September 8. Rally Day will begin our time change for having Sunday School at 9:00 AM and then our Worship Service at 10:00 AM. Rally Day reminds people of the idea that now that summer is over, let's "rally together" as we start a new Fall Season! So, we thought this is a great time to introduce our new time changes as we launch our new Children's Ministry! Although there will not be an "official" or "regular" Sunday School on September 8, we thought it would be a great chance for everyone to check out what has been done in the Children's Sunday School rooms beginning at 9:00 AM. We had a chance earlier this year to check out the Education Wing with the Library all fixed up and the Nursery being cleaned out and painted. Now you will have a chance to see what has been done across the hall in the Children's Sunday School rooms.

We are seeing this as an Open House with activities taking place for kids and a way to discover what Tabor Church is all about. This will begin at 9:00 AM. The goal is for the children to begin attending a Sunday School class on September 15 at 9:00 AM. They will begin with songs and then a time of teaching. All children should be picked up at 9:45 AM so that all can be in the Sanctuary for our Worship Service at 10:00 AM.

On Rally Day our Worship Service will have a special time for children and an inspiring message for adults. The children will be dismissed to Junior Church after their special time at worship. Please don't forget, your children should be picked up after the worship service and join everyone for our Rally Day Picnic! Perhaps you can bring a side dish or dessert to share? Or most importantly, just bring yourself - there is always plenty of food!

So please mark your calendar - Adult Sunday School and Children's Sunday School will begin at 9:00 AM and end at 9:45 AM and then our Worship Service will begin at 10:00 AM followed afterwards by a time of fellowship every Sunday.





## From the Deacon's Desk...

### ARE YOU LISTENING?

As I am writing this, the church just heard in a sermon about the Holy Spirit and freedom in Christ. The Scripture used was from Galatians 5:16-18 "So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want, but if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law." "Led by the Spirit". How well do you do at this?

At a recent time of prayer on Wednesday night, we were to listen to the Holy Spirit and pray what we felt the Spirit was saying we should pray about. Maybe it was just me, but I thought it was a powerful time of prayer. To be honest, I think that is how a time of prayer becomes powerful. When the Spirit is in charge, it can't help but be powerful. That is what our prayers are to be about. We are to ask the Holy Spirit to give us guidance and wisdom. The Holy Spirit is what Jesus promised to His followers in the Bible.

As I was thinking on this I came across a story that reminded me of how important it is to listen to the Holy Spirit. So I know what you are thinking: I try to hear but don't, I can't tell if it is the Holy Spirit talking to me or just my inner voice, how can I be confident that it is the Spirit and not just me? Maybe you are thinking that we need some "holy" time to hear the Holy Spirit. I can remember a time when I was just out walking my dog and I really felt that God was speaking to me. It was one of those moments that I thought, "I could never think that one on my own". It must have been God speaking to me.

I was reading a story about a woman who was mowing her lawn and felt the Holy Spirit speak to her. She said "I was not fasting or praying, I was not in a worship service, I was not thinking Spiritual thoughts. I was cutting the grass." To me that reminded me of the times I walked my dog and would later go to the Pastor at the time and say "This is what I heard God say to me, what do you think?" It was always something that I should do at the church and so was looking for confirmation as to whether it would work in the church. The writer

said as she was riding her lawn tractor, navigating around trees, her thoughts about the upcoming week were silenced by a voice that didn't belong to her. The voice said "If Timothy tells you he is joining the military, tell him you will be proud of him". Apparently, she did not accept it as truth right away and said "What?" With patience, the Holy Spirit spoke the message again.

The story told about how her son had just turned 18 and was a senior in high school. He had put out applications for college and had received acceptance letters and scholarship notifications. The author said that she struggled to understand why she would have heard this message. It seemed unnecessary. So, she finished mowing and put everything away. Her son was working and so he was not home and it seemed like the message was just going to sit there for awhile. When her son came home they talked about his day. After that, she was sitting on the floor sorting through papers when her son said "I'm going to join the National Guard". Reasons for him to reconsider immediately came to her mind but died on the tip of her tongue. It was then that she understood the message from the Holy Spirit. So she said to her son "If you join the military, I will be proud of you." It was in that moment that she realized that the Spirit had prepared her for the unexpected. She believes that the work of the Spirit preserved her relationship with her son.

She ended her story with this "I have learned whether we receive a message from the Holy Spirit in a horse-drawn chariot or on a Craftsman chariot, through fasting and prayer, or when we think we don't have a prayer, His timing is perfect, and He keeps His Word. Always." I hope you believe that with all of Your heart. We can rely on God to speak to us through His Spirit. We don't have to be in a "holy" moment. We just have to be open to hearing from Him. If there comes a time when You feel you heard from the Holy Spirit and it involves a ministry you might be called to do, follow up with someone you trust and see if it is something that makes sense. Don't ignore the message thinking "I could never do that!". Trust that if God gives you the message, that He will provide what is needed to fulfill what He has called you to do. He speaks to us about our calling, He speaks to us about how we should pray, who we should pray for, and how we can accomplish His work. Trust Him and be obedient.

## DO YOU EVER FEEL THE NEED TO COME TO CHURCH ALONE AND SPEND TIME WITH GOD?



There was a time in my life when at Christmas time, I would come to the Sanctuary late at night and turn on only the Christmas lights in the Sanctuary. I treasured that time because it felt like it was just me and God. I didn't really go there to pray, just to sit with God. It was a "Be still and know that I am God" moment.

Have you ever had those moments when you have felt the need to just sit and be quiet before God and spend time in His presence? Maybe that can't happen in your home with all the noise or reminders of things to be done. The Wednesday night prayer group will occasionally re-evaluate what that prayer time is about and how we can be more effective in prayer for others. In a recent discussion, we have come up with the idea that Classroom 8 (the lounge) will now be known as the Prayer Room.

We would like to see the Prayer Room established for several reasons. We want it to be a place to come and just be still and quiet before God. You certainly can also go in the Sanctuary or the Chapel but we wanted a smaller place for an individual to go. We also would like it to be a place where you can ask someone to go in there to pray for you. Sometimes we just need a private place to have someone pray for us. We were also thinking that if someone needed a place to be prayed for and didn't feel comfortable about going up front at the end of the service, they could go with you to the prayer room where your concerns would be prayed for privately.

And don't forget, on the third Wednesday of the month at 5:30 to 6:30 PM, you can come to our prayer time and we can have a team pray for you there or they can take you to the prayer room to receive prayer. Sometimes we just need others to pray for us in agreement.

This is what will begin on Sunday, September 8. We will be changing where our prayer team will be standing during the last hymn.

They will now be in the back of the church on the side where the circle is. In addition, after the service is over, a team will be in the prayer room for anyone needing to be prayed for in a private setting. We will reinstate having a box to insert prayer concerns and those prayer concerns placed in the box will be prayed for by the team in the back and in the prayer room.

If you would like to come to church at anytime don't let not having a key stop you. The church is opened Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. If you would like to come during the evening, just call Maryanne Ditter at 215-962-2769 and she will come up to church and unlock the door for you.
