

Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in confession that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us.

Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a belief different from that of this congregation and Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive sacrament, are asked to first speak with pastor. The center cups in wooden inserts of communion trays are filled with water with addition of a single drop of wine, for those receiving communion who are unable to drink alcohol. At every communion service, Mt. Calvary offers both individual cups and common cup. If you desire to use common cup, please do not take an individual cup, wait for Pastor to bring chalice to you.
