In Case of Inclement Weather or Emergency Situations


Mt Calvary Lutheran Church encourages individuals and families to rely on their own best judgment when conditions such as inclement weather, dangerous road conditions, or other emergency situations might put their health and safety at risk by attending church services or church-related events.

- 1. Events for Children and Youth** during the week will be cancelled whenever the Indianola schools are closed due to weather conditions.
- 2. Meetings or Other Events** with the exception of Sunday morning education classes and worship services, will be cancelled at the discretion of the leader in charge of the meeting or event. The leader, with assistance from the office staff, will notify all participants.
- 3. Sunday Morning Worship Services, Special Services, and Christian Education** may be cancelled at the determination of the Church President and Chairman of the Elders Board in consultation with the Pastor at any time. If conditions exist or have been forecasted to have a potential impact to above services, a collective decision will be made by those parties or someone delegated to represent them at that time. Examples of conditions to impact these services are the following but not limited to extreme cold temperatures, heavy snowfall, excessive icing conditions, and any physical issues to the church in which would harm its members and guests. All decisions will be communicated to the congregation as quickly as possible through a variety of communication channels.
