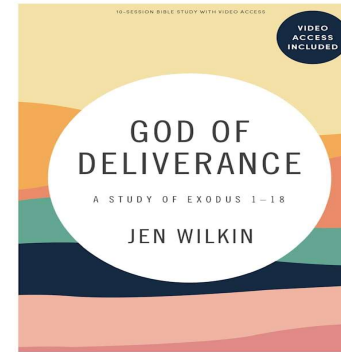

SOWN TOGETHER — Summer Sunday School for the Whole Family
June 7 through August 23 – We will meet in the fellowship hall at 9:25 am.

Sown Together is a whole-family Sunday School experience where children, parents, and grandparents learn side by side. Each week we will explore one of the Parables of Jesus — those short, surprising stories where Jesus turns the world upside down and shows us what God is really like.
