

Choose 1 novel listed below. Your job this summer is to read.


As you read, you must annotate at least 5 chapters. They need to be spread across the book.

Robinson Crusoe








While going through possessions of a deceased guest who owed them money, the mistress of the inn and her son find a treasure map which leads to a pirate's fortune as well as great danger.




