Dear Enon Chapel Baptist Church,

Making Jesus known remains the greatest joy and calling of the **Baptist Children's Homes (BCH)** ministry. For Easter, I am grateful for the opportunity to share a story of life transformation that the kindness of your church has helped make possible.

Since we serve boys and girls from some of the most vulnerable situations across North Carolina, I will refer to this young lady as "Tiffany." Today, Tiffany is a radiant 15 year old who is thriving at BCH's Mills Home campus — but in October 2025, when she first came to us, she arrived with a heavy heart.

Through the loving care of her cottage parents, the Lyles and the Grimes families, Tiffany has seen the gospel lived out with Christ-like compassion. She has participated in daily devotions, joined discipleship times at Mills Home Baptist Church, and watched other girls courageously follow Jesus in baptism.

One afternoon, after discipleship, she went to Kathy Lyles, her cottage mother.

*"Mrs. Kathy, guess what I just learned... I was created for a purpose."*

Tiffany was learning more about faith, salvation, and baptism. Patiently and lovingly, her cottage parents walked through the gospel with her — how Jesus, God's Son, died on the cross for our sins, and rose again so we could have new life in Him.

Tiffany not only understood — she believed. *Tiffany shared that she had prayed and placed her trust in Jesus as her Savior.*

And then came the joyful day we now celebrate. During a Sunday service at Mills Home Baptist Church, Tiffany stepped into the baptistry with Pastor Luis. Surrounded by other children, cottage parents, and friends, she publicly declared her faith in Jesus Christ. When Pastor Luis brought her up out of the water, her smile lit the sanctuary — and the cheers from her BCH family rang out in celebration.

All the girls that we've seen baptized were so nervous, but not Tiffany," Kathy said. "She was thrilled."

Stories like Tiffany's are why BCH exists — and why your partnership is so vital.
