#### Pastor's Broadcaster Article - July 2025

REST: What is your ideal location to rest? Is it a shaded woods, a fluffy bean bag, a tropical beach, or under a down blanket? Is it alone, or with a special someone/s?

As you picture this place of rest, I want you to see how a place of rest is described in 2 bible verses. There are more mentions of rest, but here are two.

Matthew 11:28-30 (**New Living Translation**) <sup>28</sup> Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light."

Notice how the condition of this verse shows us carrying a heavy burden. But, instead of no burden, the burden that Jesus suggests is a new burden, a new task, a new leadership. Trust is Jesus is a form of rest, because we can be confident in Jesus' leadership, and not required to do our tasks and weights alone.

**Psalm 91:1-3 (New Living Translation)** <sup>1</sup> Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. <sup>2</sup> This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; he is my God, and I trust him. <sup>3</sup> For he will rescue you from every trap and protect you from deadly disease.

See how the location of rest is with God, and it is the best rest? There is mention of danger elsewhere, but safety with God. This should not surprise us, a condition of rest requires safety. If it is a dangerous place, or a wild place, it would not be as restful. Rest in God and trust in God while we sleep or work is found when we are with God. So, do not look for rest elsewhere, trust in the rest that is described in these few verses.
