TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: LUKE 1:39-56

ADVENT: PEACE

Our text this week, Luke 1:39–55, explores where two mothers—Elizabeth and Mary—experience God’s miraculous work in their lives. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, blesses Mary and her unborn child, recognizing the coming of the Messiah. In response, Mary lifts her voice in the Magnificat, a beautiful song of praise celebrating God’s mercy, faithfulness, and mighty deeds. As we reflect on these songs, we are reminded that true peace does not come from our circumstances, which are often uncertain or challenging. Instead, it comes from receiving Jesus with joy and responding in worship to all that God has done.

COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

Take time to think through these questions and write down some responses as you prepare to meet with your group.

READ	THINK	PRAY	STUDY	RETURN
Try to read the study text at least 5x this week. Get familiar with the flow of thought, the main idea, and major divisions.	Meditate on the truth of the text letting it resonate in your heart throughout the day. Chew on what you learn. Fight forgetfulness.	Pray through the text, asking God to teach you His Word so that you can know it and apply it. Praise him for the truths revealed in this passage of Scripture.	Seek to answer the questions below. They are intended to help you read carefully, think clearly, and pray specifically	Bring this sheet with the fruit of your study. Be prepared to discuss the passage. If other questions arise as you study, bring those too!

1 Why did Mary go to visit Elizabeth without hesitation, and what does this reveal about her relationship with God and her understanding of Him?

2 Elizabeth and John responded to Jesus' presence with joy. How can you recognize and welcome Jesus with that same joy in your daily life?

3 Mary's Magnificat is filled with praise for God's mighty deeds and faithfulness. When you think about your life, what are some ways you've seen God's power or mercy at work recently? How does recognizing these things shape your worship and gratitude?

4 Mary responded to unexpected news with faith and rejoicing. How do you usually respond when God's plans for your life are surprising, uncertain, or not what you had in mind for your life? What can we learn from Mary about responding with joy and trust?

5 The Magnificat emphasizes God lifting the humble, bringing down the proud, and showing mercy to the faithful. How should this vision of God's justice and mercy influence the way we live and interact with others in our daily lives?
