When I was a Youth Intern for a congregation outside of St. Louis, one of the men from the congregation took me fishing for a day on the largest inland lake in Illinois, Lake Carlyle. It was a hot summer day, but we were catching fish like crazy. We caught over 130 fish that day. In fact, we were having so much fun catching fish that a severe thunderstorm snuck up on us quickly. The storm turned that calm lake into a ferocious sea. This lake was so huge that we could not see land where we were. The storm cut us off from our boat dock, so we had to beach our boat and sought refuge in an uninhabited area around the lake. It was getting dark, by the time the storm passed by, so we had to navigate huge waves going back to the dock. Those waves beat us to death. Gary told me to cinch up my life jacket tightly because it was so dangerous. We made it back to shore, but it was a harrowing adventure.

Life is like that adventure in general. Sometimes, life can seem so calm and placid and then before you know it, we find ourselves in the midst of a storm. This morning, we are going to look into The Word to find lasting peace, no matter the weather or season in life. Thank you for being with us today! I pray our time together will be a blessing!
