

The BAS Fall Festival is this Sunday,





# **FUN FACTS:**

- Dead skin cells are a main ingredient in household dust. According to researchers at Imperial College London,
  humans shed around 200 million skin cells each hour—and they have to go somewhere when we're indoors. If
  the idea of skin dust isn't sitting well with you, you should know that a report from the American Chemical
  Society found that a skin oil called squalene naturally helps reduce indoor ozone levels by up to 15 percent.
