**Title:** The Pride That Ends In Destruction

**Text:** Proverbs 16:18

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## Discussion Guide

1. What stood out to you in today's gathering?
2. How would you define the pride that leads to destruction?
3. Do you think everyone struggles with sinful and destructive pride or only some people? Why or why not?
4. In 2 Chronicles 26:16 we are told about Uzziah, "But when he was strong, he grew proud, to his destruction. For he was unfaithful to the Lord his God..." How does success set us up to become proud? How does pride lead to destruction?
5. Jack Bernard wrote about Adam and Eve, "Pride was the original sin of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. They desired to be 'like god, knowing good and evil' (Gen 3:5). They wanted to be able to make autonomous judgments and direct their own lives. They no longer wanted to need God. Every time we choose our own will over God's will, we re-enact that scene in the garden." How were Adam and Eve delusional concerning themselves, God, and their relationship with God?
6. What is one takeaway from today's message that you believe the Lord is prompting you to live out in your life?

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
