To Awaken Hearts

Mission 66 has become a collection of Bible study tools designed to help people encounter God's Word, no matter their circumstances. Through audio commentaries, study guides, and YouVersion devotion plans, Mission 66 equips individuals to read, reflect, and apply Scripture in meaningful ways.



A nurse in central Africa wrote: *"During long night shifts at the maternity ward, I kept my small transistor tuned to Mission 66. I needed something to keep me awake, but it ended up awakening me."* It was through the Word, spoken through Mission 66, that she came to know the Giver of Life. Her quiet prayer in the staff room marked the start of her walk with Christ.

The flagship *Mission 66* audio programs journey through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation in two and a half years. Hosted by John Mathews and Esther Sisulu, these half-hour episodes offer fresh insights from Brazilian Bible scholar, Dr. Luiz Sayão's, biblical teachings. Designed to meet people in their daily routines, Mission 66 has transformed lives, such as a maternity ward nurse who first encountered God through the program and gave her life to Christ during a night shift.

Mission 66 also delivers concise, focused resources through YouVersion's Bible App devotion plans. For example, one of these plans being developed focuses on Christ's final week—His humility, sacrificial love, and victorious resurrection as chronicled through Mark 11-16. Please pray for the review process, and that this plan will bring a fresh understanding of Christ's love for all people!

Looking Back & Recognizing God's Faithfulness in 2025

Romans 8:28 reminds us: “And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.”

Many of us know this verse well—but it can feel harder to trust when circumstances are difficult.

As we look back on 2025, we can affirm that this promise is true, even though many things still don't feel “worked together.” Some situations remain unresolved. Some answers have not yet come. And often, what we think of as *good* is not the same as what God defines as good. Our perspective is limited. My own understanding of “good” can feel like a horse wearing blinders—focused only on what is right in front of me and centered on the people I love. But God's view is far broader. He is working not only for our personal good, but also within His greater, eternal purpose. Remembering this allows us to pause and breathe. God is attentive to our lives and our needs, even as He continues to carry out His bigger plan.

Romans 8:28 also reminds us that this promise is for those who are “called according to His purpose.” Scripture helps us understand that calling. First Corinthians 1:9 tells us, “God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.” What is that calling? Fellowship with the sovereign King of kings—into a relationship grounded in the unchanging faithfulness of God.

Looking Forward Expectantly in 2026

Even though life keeps changing, we can look to the future with confidence because God does not change. He remains faithful—and He has a proven track record. Scripture reminds us, “He who calls you is faithful; He will surely do it” (1 Thessalonians 5:24).

Time and again, God has shown us that He is with us, working all things according to His purposes. He has a plan, and because of that, we live with expectant hope in our Savior. He is the One who saves and continues to keep our feet from stumbling. As we step into each new day, we fix our eyes on our King—our Treasure and our Hope.
