

## Sermon Notes for March 22, 2026

**Title:** Maintaining Integrity on Mission

**Text:** Acts 18:1-23

Main point: If we want to remain \_\_\_\_\_

for Christ, we must carry out His mission with \_\_\_\_\_.

Some Ways to Further Engage:

- Spend time in 1 Corinthians in order to discover more about the context of Paul's ministry in Acts 18.
- Read Ezekiel 33:1-9. Paul quotes it in Acts 18:6. How might this passage have impacted Paul's own sense of responsibility to make the gospel's demands and warnings clear?
- Think of someone in your life who you would consider to have a lot of integrity. What are some things about them that inform this picture you have of them? How might you imitate them?
- Read Luke's account of Jesus's trial and crucifixion (Luke 22:66-23:49) while meditating on Jesus's *innocence*.
- Sharing the gospel's *demands* and *warnings* can be the scariest part of evangelizing. How might you tell someone that rejecting Jesus leads to being separated from God forever? Practice sharing the gospel to yourself without leaving this part out.

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## Discussion Guide

1. What stood out to you in today's gathering?
2. After the gospel message was rejected by the Jews, Paul seemed to express that his conscience was clean when he used the phrase "Your blood be on your own heads! I am clean." (18:6). Why might Paul say this? Have you ever passed on an opportunity to share the gospel with someone even though you felt Jesus calling you to do it? How did you feel afterward? What did it teach you?
3. Jesus spurred on Paul's ministry when He promised him through a vision "Do not be afraid, but go on speaking and do not be silent; for I am with you, and no one will lay a hand on you in order to harm you, for I have many people in this city." (18:9-10). While these promises are specifically given to Paul, how are these same truths applicable to the Church's mission today? To our mission in Rock Rapids?
4. What is at least one way you will further engage with today's message from the list above?
5. What is one takeaway from today's message that you believe the Lord is prompting you to live out in your life?

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
