#### Mission 66 Proclaiming God's Love

Mission 66 is a new Bible-teaching series on TWR. The Spanish version for South, Central and North America began in early October last year.

## What is Unique About Mission 66?

Mission 66 originated in Brazil. Theologian and Bible scholar, Dr. Luiz Sayao, initiated the program in his native Portuguese language.

# Why Did Dr. Sayao Create the Program?

In an interview on the program
Footsteps, Dr. Sayao explained the
purpose this way: It's a Bible
commentary in audio form. We are
trying to explain the Biblical text in a
way that people will be able to
understand and apply in their lives.
It is made in a way that people who
are not religious or don't attend a
church can understand.

He went on to talk about how much of society is secular and have received misinformation. They may find Christianity confusing and may have a prejudice against the Bible. But Dr. Sayao wants to overcome these challenges and show how the Bible is beautiful and is the truth.
