Faithful Families Reflect Jesus

I recently read an article which stated, "a Godly home is like an embassy of heaven." That made me think for a while. Although no home is perfect, because none of us are perfect, all of our homes should reflect God's grace and love. When someone steps into your home they should sense the presence of Christ. Let me share with you some characteristics of a Christ focused home.

Characteristics of a Christ focused home:

- 1. Jesus is the foundation. Jesus is the foundation for our lives, and He needs to become the foundation for our homes. 1 Corinthians 3:11
- 2. **The Bible is read, spoken, and obeyed.** The Bible is God's word and full of His wisdom; make it an important part of your family. Psalm 119:105
- 3. **Prayer happens.** We must pray individually and pray as a family. Your children will learn how to pray as they listen to you pray, so let them hear you pray regularly. Colossians 1:9
- 4. **Loving actions.** Showing love to one another is an important part of how a Christian family functions. Love should be seen in every relationship in your family. Husbands and wives need to love one another. Parents and children should love one another. Siblings should love one another. 1 Corinthians 16:14
- 5. **Truth is spoken in love.** What we say to each other is as important as how we say it. Always seek to speak the truth and do so in love. 1 Corinthians 16:14
- 6. Patience and kindness are seen every day. How would your family be different if patience and kindness were seen every day? Right now, decide that you are going to be more kind with your words and with your actions and show more patience to those around you. You will be surprised at the difference it will make in your family. 1 Corinthians 13:4
- 7. **Joy and laughter are abundant.** I have never met a family which does not need to laugh a little more or express joy more often. As your family discovers the things which make them laugh and fill their hearts with joy, do them often. Proverbs 17:22
- 8. Learning never ends. I love to learn new things but not all the things I learn help me grow spiritually. I most recently learned that it takes a caterpillar about a month to become a butterfly. While that may be an incredible piece of knowledge it does not necessarily grow my spirit. Make sure some of the things you learn are things which grow your spirit. Ephesians 3:19

Are these characteristics evident in your home? If there are a couple you need to work on, talk to your family, pray about them together, and then commit to making some changes.
