A Note from Pastor John:

The other day I walked into a store and in the main display area they had decorations for Halloween, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. Well, if I have a choice, I pick Christmas. To help us start thinking about Christmas, let me ask you a question: What is your favorite Christmas Bible verse?

Here are a few I can think of:

Therefore, the Lord Himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive, have a son, and name Him Immanuel. *Isaiah 7:14 HCSB*

For a child will be born for us, a Son will be given to us, and the government will be on His shoulders. He will be named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 The dominion will be vast, and its prosperity will never end. He will reign on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish and sustain it with justice and righteousness from now on and forever. The zeal of the Lord of Hosts will accomplish this. *Isaiah 9:6-7 HCSB*

When they saw the star, they were overjoyed beyond measure. 11 Entering the house, they saw the child with Mary His mother, and falling to their knees, they worshiped Him. Then they opened their treasures and presented Him with gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. 12 And being warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their own country by another route. *Matthew 2:10-12 HCSB*

When the time came to completion, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. *Galatians 4:4-5 HCSB*

There are many more, but consider this one for a moment:

But the angel said to them, "Don't be afraid, for look, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people: 11 Today a Savior, who is Messiah the Lord, was born for you in the city of David. *Luke 2:10 HCSB*

Good news of great joy...I think that is a message our world can use right now. I know it is a message I can use and I'm sure it is one you can use as well. The pressures, pains, difficulties, fears, and hurts of our world often steal our joy. Sometimes it's subtle, other times it feels like an assault upon our soul. However it happens, it leaves you feeling empty inside, with a frown on your face. Our world seems to hate joy.

But the good news is, Jesus is our source for joy! Not only is He our source but He constantly fills us with His joy. Do you need some joy?
