Thank. Reflect. Pause. Prepare. Praise. Ponder.

This month, we begin a special time of year in the church when we thank, reflect, pause, prepare, praise, and ponder.

We begin with Thanksgiving, which is not officially part of the Christian calendar, but has become a day when we take time to give thanks to God for our blessings. We gather with family and friends to enjoy our relationships and recognize the gift of God's abundance.

Then comes Christ the King Sunday, which is the last Sunday of the church calendar. It is a day when we look back at all the seasons of the church year to reflect on what God has done and look forward in anticipation of what God will do.

And finally at the end of November we begin the new church year with the season of Advent.

This year for Advent, we will take time to Pause, Prepare, Praise, and Ponder.

Pause – Psalm 46; 2 Peter 3:8-15; Matthew 6:25.34
God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in times of trouble. God asks us to "be still and know that I am God." To look forward to the new heaven and new earth, but in the meantime, to wait patiently and peacefully for the Lord. We must trust in the Lord and not worry, for God cares for us more than the birds of the air and the lilies of the field.

In the wilderness, prepare the way of the Lord!
