
On behalf of our continuing outreach to our neighbors and those in need, we recently made a donation of diapers and wipes to Lutheran Social Services!

# This month please welcome - Cally Anderson and Miia Johnson



#### KIVA.ORG

Schokolade is now a memory of a fun and tasty evening of a chocolate buffet. Blood sugar levels are back to normal. Yet, life does not just go on day after day. The \$1400 has been invested in loans via KIVA, a worldwide non-profit that is the 'middle person' funneling loans of \$25 or more to people all over the world to begin or to enhance their businesses.

An on-going display is in the church narthex to track the loans—who we loaned to, how much, and what they will do with the money to improve their lives. The Generosity Team chose 10 women across the world to partner with. See the write ups and map in the narthex. In fact, we have had several monthly payments made already which allowed us to reinvest in an 11th person. (plant, harvest, repeat).

Ma in the Philippines borrowed \$200 for fertilizer and pesticides. 5 groups loaned \$25 each and Schokolade money loaned \$75. Repayment is over 12 months. Our first check was for \$5.90.

Faheema lives in Palestine borrowed 4000 138 lenders came together (including us for \$85) so that she could buy a new refrigerator and oven. She makes pastries and sells them at the local farmer's market.

Thank you to all who helped take an amazing evening and make it into seeds of change for 10 families around the world. Oops. Make that 11. Uhh, make that 20 by the end of this year....kind of like the feeding of the 5000....

# WARM YOUR HEART COMMUNITY CLOTHESLINE and FOOD PANTRY

Spring is here and summer is just around the corner, but let's keep contributing to our Community Clothesline.

Do you have extra jackets, shirts, sweatshirts, pants, shoes, T-Shirts, etc....? I'm sure any type of clothing will be helpful.

You can help your neighbors by putting each item in a plastic bag to keep it dry, labeling it (for example, "child hat, size M" or "men's jacket, size XL"), and clip it anywhere on the 'clothesline' [on the fence] on the west side of the church! (Clothespins are on site). The Community Clothesline is accessible at all times (24/7) from both the north and south parking lots.

We also have a Community Food Pantry next to the clothesline for putting nonperishable food items, personal care items, and paper products.
