

Our History

1973

Rev. Ernie Hautala and his family arrived in the Philippines and began an evangelistic Bible Basketball program with the motto:

No Bible, No Basketball.

Word of Life Bible Institute began under the leadership of Rev. Joe Mauk.

Rev. Mike Foster became the director of Word of Life Philippines.

2002

As the lease on the first camp property expired, the new 40-acre Calauan, Laguna Camp property was dedicated with Word of Life co-founder Harry Bollback.

1977

Word of Life Philippines was given a 19-acre coconut plantation in Rizal, Laguna for 25 years at no cost. This became the first youth camp property. Ernie liked to say,

Engaging college students of the University of the Philippines Los Baños with the Gospel and discipling those who come to know Christ.




Camps & Retreats

Word of Life Philippines Ministry Framework

All of Word of Life Philippines' ministries operate in collaboration with local churches, to help equip local churches for evangelism and discipleship.



The Local Church Ministries (LCM) exists to equip local churches in developing their youth ministry through evangelism and discipleship. LCM provides resources, training, and youth events to achieve their goals.

Training




STORM (Sending Teens Out to Reach the Masses)

Helps teens get into God's Word through an interactive daily devotional which includes a prayer journal and Bible reading plan.



Urbangelize

Evangelistic training in the context of heavily populated/ urban areas.



ID4ME (Intense Discipleship is for Me)

A 10-day fast-track leadership training for youth workers who desire to grow their youth ministry in theory and practice.



Core Training

A youth event facilitated to help local churches get started on leading the youth through a structured program.



TEAM Meeting (Teaching, Encouragement, Accountability, Motivation)

Weekly online meetings with youth leaders in partner churches to help them stay motivated in the youth ministry.

School of Biblical Studies

A one-year program designed to train students to be deeply rooted in God's Word. Students are taught how to look at Scripture in context; apply God's truth to their lives through spiritual disciplines, discipleship, and service work; and share God's Word through a variety of ministry experiences.

School of Ministerial Studies

A three-year continuation of the SBS program designed to equip students to study God's Word in-depth, provide them practical tools and leadership training, and prepare them for full-time work through different ministry experiences.



The Riverside Property

God has recently answered a prayer of almost 20 years! In 2019, we were able to acquire 11.8 acres of property which connects our current Laguna Camp across the river. With more than 18,000 campers coming through the Laguna Camp in 2019, the Riverside Property perfectly fits the needs of our growing ministry! We are looking forward to expanding the camping experience, welcoming more guests, and reaching out to more young people with the Gospel.





In September 2019, our staff family started clearing the brush and jungle at the Riverside Property. The property is now ready for tent camping and other recreational activities!





Pretty attended the Bible Institute in 2002 after being encouraged by her sister who was already serving with WOL. After her graduation, God lead her to Malaysia as a teacher to serve Muslim young people. After a year serving there, God brought her back to Word of Life Philippines where she started serving in the Laguna Camp ministry.


In 2004, God first led me to Word of Life through work teams which were being sent by local churches in Lansing, IL. On my third trip in 2006, God began working in my heart and gave me the desire to study at the Bible Institute. That same year, I returned 3 months later to the Philippines and began to study.

Pretty and I were married in November of 2006 and our first ministry was serving in the University Campus. During that time, our first child, John, was born. We spent one year as short-term Missionaries here before making the change to full time in 2009. We spent 14 months in the US raising support and preparing to return to the Philippines. In 2010, our second child, Hannah, was born.

After returning to the Philippines, God lead me to join our Evangelism Department. We worked with organizing ministries on the weekend for Bible Institute Students as well as doing sports ministry trips throughout the country. These were amazing years of seeing many people come to Christ and learning much about what is was to be a missionary.












Please pray as we begin training more and more international students who will return to their home countries eager to start Word of Life Ministries and impact their nation with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.





This vast region of the world is home to more than half of the world's population and geography.
