
Pastor Jamil Sadiq from Pakistan has come to Fort Wayne, IN as a Missionary to help Train & Reach the Muslim community for Christ!

Introduction

For the People of the Crescent
The Message of the Cross
Through the Eyes of Jonah

Jonah's book is simple and straightforward, a plain message without confusion. It exposes God's heart for His lost creation. The story is appealing, it catches our imagination and delights a child's heart. But, in fact, it is not just a story, it is the true message of YHWH God who is faithful and whose heart beats for the nations.

Three Essential Facts about Jonah's Book:

a) Simplicity b) Sublimity c) Supremacy

a) Simplicity

- 1. The book begins with the words and and now.
- a) And: (YLT Young Literal Translation) The dictionary defines and: "A conjunction word used to connect words of the same parts of speech, clauses, or sentences that are to be taken jointly."

Now: ([King James Version (KJV), New King James Version (NKJV), and American Standard Version (ASV) started it with the word now.

Defined as "the present time or moment; or it is used to draw someone's attention towards a particular statement or point in a narrative."

- b) I believe the sixty-six books of the Holy Bible, beginning at Genesis 3:15; 17:18, Isaiah 60:7 and continuing throughout Revelation, remind us of the continued story of a Missionary God. The psalmist shouted in Psalm 33:11, "The plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations."
- This book does not narrate the prophecies, instead it tells the story of a reluctant and running prophet.

B) Sublimity

- Jonah is the Old Testament's Evangelist. The Book of Jonah is the Old Testament's Gospel. Jonah explains the typology of Jesus' death and resurrection, the Great Commission, and God's final revelation of grace and love.
- This is the only book in the Old Testament that reveals God's gracious heart for the nations of the world. It contains the gospel message. This is why it is called foolishness by worldly scholars.
- 3. No matter how disobedient the prophet, the writing became part of God's Holy Book.

C) Supremacy

- It speaks directly to the desperation of people who are not Israelites or Jewish, and who know only worldviews which rest in hope for this present world. For example, paganism teaches that if an action harms no one, do whatever you will. There is no hope for forgiveness of sin or eternal life.
- 2. It depicts the concern of the Creator God of the Universe, the Great I Am, for His rebellious and stubborn creation mankind, whom he made in his own image! (Genesis 1:27)
- 3. It unveils the perspective of the people of Israel who ignore the peril of the nations of the world. It introduces YHWH God's missionary heart for the nations of the world!

I believe that the book of Jonah contains an essential message for the people of the Crescent. Why do I believe this? It is the message of the Cross. We will explore this.

JONAH: A reluctant and running prophet. Jonah spelled as an acronym "Jesus offers nations anointed heart" could be God's humor. He is able to bring good from evil. (See Appendix A to read Jonah's story by Islamic perspective)
