
HEROES OF THE FAITH

MOSES: Forbidden Sexual Relations

- Laws against incest (vv. 1-18)
 - ✤ <u>"I am the LORD your God."</u> (vv. 1-5)
 - \Box God spoke to Moses. (v. 1)
 - □ <u>He commanded Moses to remind Israel He alone is God</u>. (v. 2)
 - <u>Genesis 2:4</u>: יְהֹוָה אֱלֹהִים (Yehovah Eloheem) = self existent; eternal; true God
 Trinity over creation (Colossians 1:15-17)
 - John 1:1-3: The eternality of the Trinity.
 - <u>Revelation 1:8</u>: The names of eternal God.
 - <u>Revelation 22:12-13</u>: The names of the eternal One Jesus Christ.
 - □ Israel's worship of holy God was to be unique. (v. 3)
 - Do not misplace your worship, like the Egyptians - looking back.
 - Do not misplace your worship, like the Canaanites - looking forward.
 - <u>Do not walk in the same sin</u>.
 - Exodus 20:3-5
 - Exodus 34:14
 - □ Worship God. Obey God. Follow God. Love God. (v. 4)
 - □ Live by God's Word, His Law. The God of the universe wanted relationship with them. (v. 5)
 - ✤ <u>The forbidden degrees of relationship</u> (vv. 6-18)
 - □ Extensive intermarriage resulted in tragic abnormalities.
 - □ It destroyed the freedom of the family to have normal love & intimacy without sexual overtones.
 - \Box In a polygamous society, these rules were quite necessary.
 - □ Under certain circumstances, incest was common in antiquity.
 - □ <u>NOTE</u>: For three generations prior to Moses, Egypt's pharaohs married their half-sisters to maintain the kingship in the royal family.
 - God forbade sexual relations/marriage with close relatives either by blood or marriage. (v. 6)
 - "<u>Uncover nakedness</u>" In OT, most commonly a euphemism for sexual intercourse. At times, it can refer to voyeurism gaining sexual pleasure from watching one who lay in nakedness, or engaging in sexual activity (Genesis 9:22-23).





- \circ <u>Father & mother</u> (v. 7)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with either parent.
- \circ <u>Father's wife</u> (v. 8)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - It shames your father the leader of his home. It shames your family, & God.
- <u>Sister</u> (v. 9)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - Whether she was reared in your family or in another family.
- o <u>Granddaughter</u> (v. 10)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - Their shame is your shame.
- <u>Sister (half sister) father's wife's daughter</u> (v. 11)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your father, his wife, her daughter, you, & God.
- <u>Aunt (father's sister)</u> (v. 12)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your father, his sister, you, & God.
- <u>Aunt (mother's sister)</u> (v. 13)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your father, mother, her sister, you, & God.
- <u>Aunt (father's brother's wife)</u> (v. 14)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your father, his brother, his brother's wife, you, & God.
- \circ <u>Daughter-n-law son's wife</u> (v. 15)
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your family, your son, his wife, you, & God.
- $\circ \quad \underline{\text{Brother's wife}} \ (v. 16)$
 - Do not commit voyeurism; or have sexual relations with her.
 - This would shame your family, your brother, his wife, you, & God.
 - Biblical exception: Levirate Marriage
 - ✓ Genesis 38:6-11
 - ✓ Deuteronomy 25:5



- Do not commit voyeurism; or, have sexual relations with close relatives. (v. 17)
 - This sin is moral failure, and it is depraved.
- <u>Prohibits polygamy the practice of having more than one wife at a time</u>. (v. 18)
 - Deuteronomy 17:14-20 (God's law concerning Israel's kings)
- Sexual Purity (vv. 19-30)
 - You shall not commit voyeurism; or have sexual relations with a woman during her menstrual uncleanness. (v. 19)
 - ◆ Do not have sexual relations with your neighbor's wife, defiling you and her. (v. 20)
 - Do not sacrifice your children to a false God Molech. There is only one God. (v. 21)
 - ↔ Homosexuality (punishable by death) is an abomination before God. (v. 22; 20:13; Rom. 1:27)
 - ✤ Men, nor women, should commit the perverted act of bestiality. (v. 23)
 - Men & women: Punishable by death / Animal: Killed
 - A wicked perversion of the holy sexual relationship between a man & woman in marriage. This showed how deeply mankind had chosen to move away from God.
 - ✤ God warned Israel not to sin in these perverted ways. (v. 24)
 - ◆ Whether an individual or an entire nation, these sins make one unclean before God.
 - ↔ When a people group defiled itself before God, God defiled their land. (v. 25)
 - ✤ Sin has consequences.
 - ✤ If Israel loved God, they would obey God. (v. 26)
 - ✤ Whether Jew or sojourner, God's expectations (commands) were the same.
 - ✤ <u>Remember...</u>
 - □ Exodus 20:1-17; Deuteronomy 5:6-22 (The Ten Commandments/Ten Words)
 - □ Exodus 24:14; 20:3,5
 - God created man to have relationship with Him.
 - □ <u>Man's biblical purpose in life</u> Genesis 2:15 + 1 Corinthians 10:31.
 - Before: Egypt defiled God & their land was defiled. (v. 27)
 <u>Future</u>: The Canaanites (the promised land) defiled God & their land was defiled.
 - ♦ God's judgment rested upon the sinner and the land where he lived. (v. 28)
 - ✤ The people who sinned in these heinous ways were ostracized from their people. (v. 29)
 - ✤ God spoke clearly: I alone am God. Listen to Me. Obey & follow Me. (v. 30)
 - □ Obey God. Honor God with the way you live.
 - □ Worship God. Give your complete allegiance and fidelity to God.



Group Questions

1) <u>Read Genesis 2:24-25. What was God's purpose in creating sex? Describe God's design for sex.</u>

<u>Read Genesis 2:15. Why did God place man in the garden of Eden? God created man for a a clear biblical purpose. It is comprised of three tenets. The noted verse provides two tenets.</u>
 <u>Go to 1 Corinthians 10:31 to find the third tenet. With these tenets before you, explain how God views sex in marriage?</u>

3) <u>God knows man's propensity toward sin is great</u>. He also knows man's proclivity toward <u>sexual sin is greater</u>. In this chapter, He forbids man's sinful passions toward incestuous <u>sexual relationships</u>. Review Genesis 2:15 and Exodus 34:14 to help you with your answer.
