

Highlights from the Board

At the February 8, 2023 Board meeting, the following items were discussed. Our income in January was less than budgeted, but so were the expenses. Pastor Jeff Robinson

noted that average Sunday attendance in January was 112 as contrasted to 97 in January of 2022. He has spent much time with the onboarding process with new Directory of Student and Worship Ministries, Patrick Corn. He proposed a special offering for IDES to address the destruction of the earthquake in Turkey and Syria. He also proposed that FCC pay for the registration for members and attendees for the Missouri Christian Convention. The Board agreed to both proposals. The special offering for IDES will be collected on Sunday, February 26. Director of Children's Ministry, Tammy Clark announced that Vacation Bible School is scheduled for July 23-28, 2023. The theme is "Stellar; Shining Jesus' Light". The hours for VBS are 6:00 to 8:30 pm each night.
