Highlights from the Board

At the January 10, 2024 Board meeting, the following items were discussed.

Financial Secretary, Betty Morris reported that we received \$50,000 from the Kathryn Phillips Trust. It enabled us to reach our budget needs for 2023.

The Worship Committee is meeting with Total Electronics about repairing some microphone inputs. They will also provide some additional training on use of the sound board.

For the Personnel Committee, Rick Jones named the Nominating Committee members who are responsible for nominating members for positions on the board. They were directed to start meeting immediately after the February board meeting.

The Property Committee reported that we have had additional complaints of a gas smell in the Sanctuary on Sunday mornings. Nevada Plumbing checked and could not find a leak in that section of the church. InetVisions replaced the switch (for wifi) in the Fellowship Hall. Later, they discovered that the cable from the Main Building to the Fellowship Hall seems to be not working. They plan to investigate further to determine if it needs to be replaced.

The Youth Committee reported that FUSE is scheduled for January 28 at First Baptist Church from 5 to 7:30pm.

In Children's Ministry, Tammy Clark reported that Little Tree Ministries has resumed and the children are learning about the Fruit of the Spirit this semester. Junior Church has resumed on the 1st and 2nd Sundays of each month. VBS is scheduled for July 21-26. IDES is the featured mission. Jeff Robinson has agreed to be here for most of the week including preaching on Sunday, July 21.

The Pastor Search Committee reported that our pastor search is up and running on the Vanderbloeman website. In about 4 weeks, the committee will meet with the Vanderbloeman representative to review candidates.

In New Business it was reported that we need more volunteers to drive the vans on Sunday morning.

Board meetings happen the second Wednesday of each month (except July) at 7:45 PM in the Church Parlor. All are welcome to attend.
