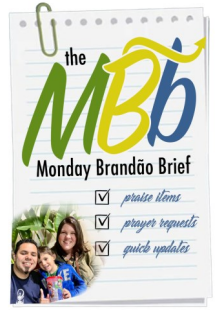
Malone Women's Basketball will be playing at the University of Findlay this Saturday, February 10th, at 1pm. Tickets can be purchased at the door.

Here is the Monday Brief for this week (January 29th):

Prayer — In two weeks is Carnaval, a Brazilian holiday. It's a big celebration especially in Sao Paulo and Rio, but sadly in a very immoral sense. So, what we do is we take our teens (+12 and up) out of the city to a camp. This year we are partnering with 5 churches to host this camp for about 100 teens from Feb 9-13. Odir will be one of the speakers and Cynthia will be doing some sessions with the girls. Pray as we are in preparation mode for this camp.
