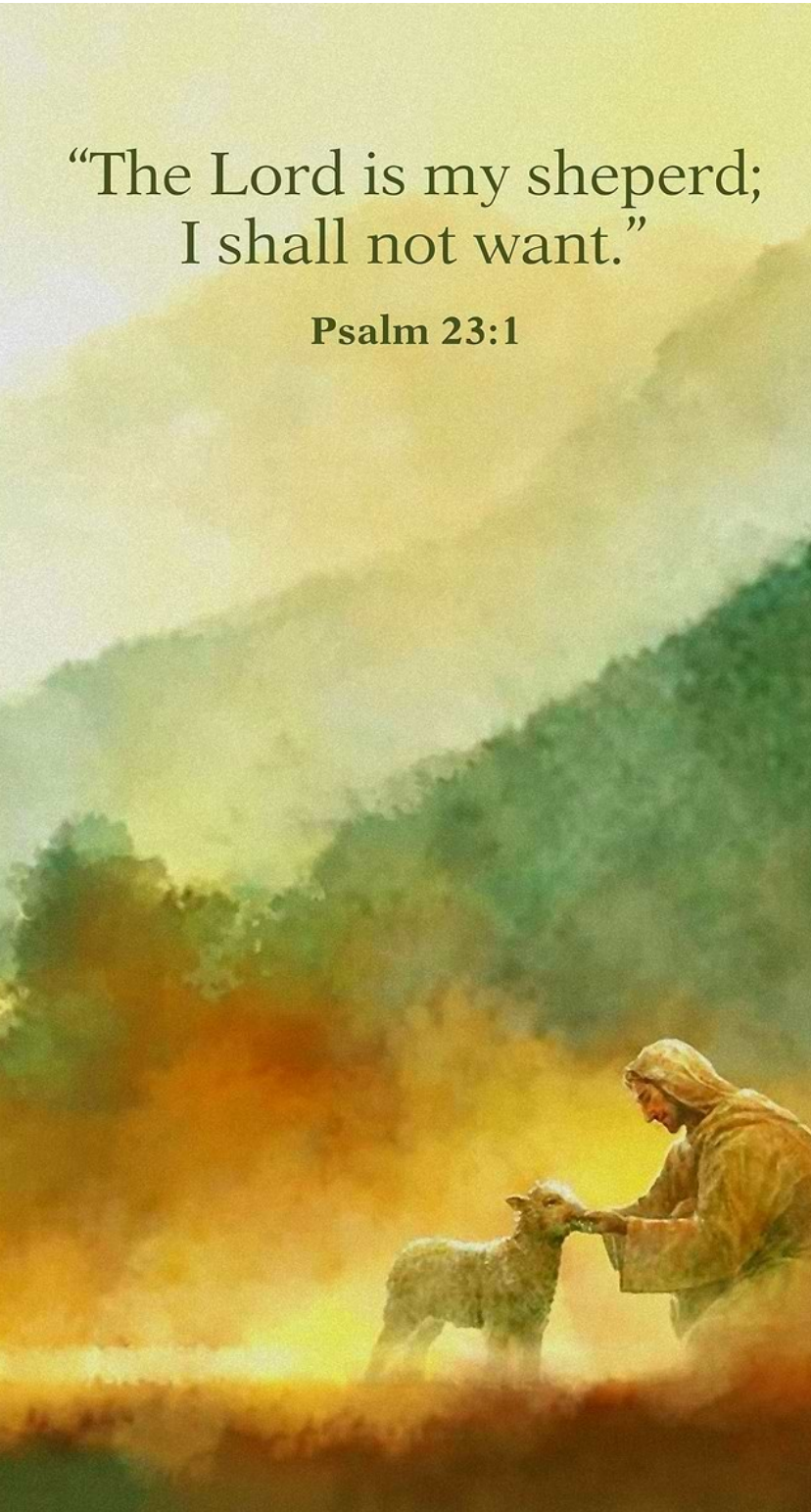

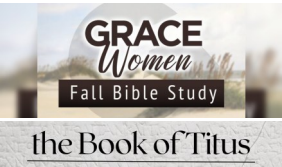

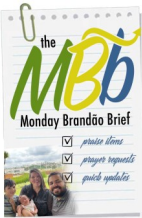
Mark your calendar - this year's Fall Fun Fest will be Sunday, October 26th, from 5-7pm

Mission's Visit

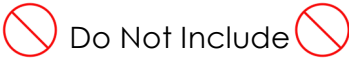
