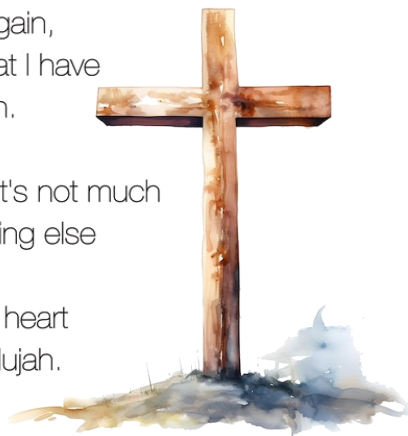

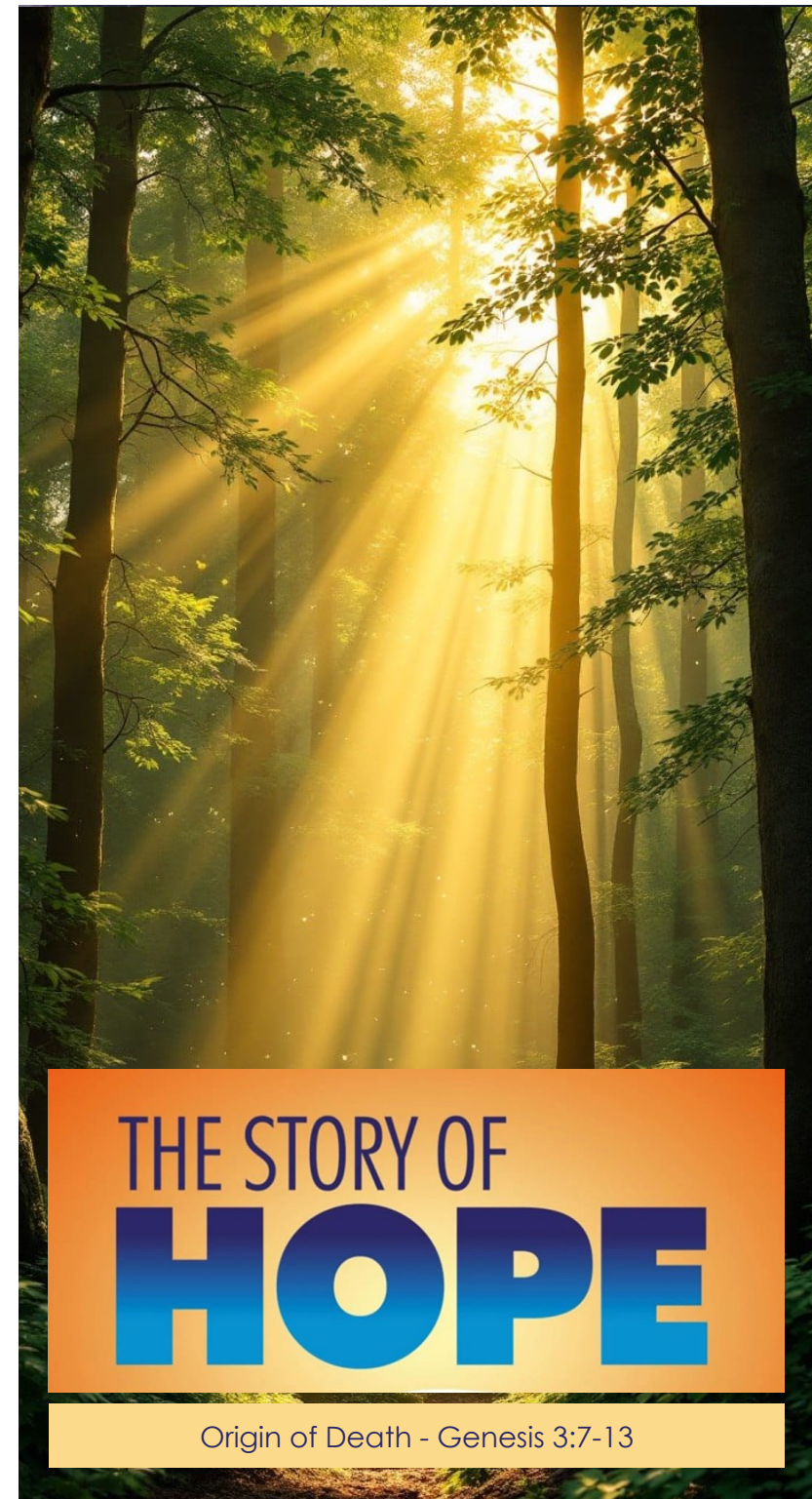

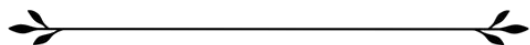
Several have expressed an interest in being certified or renewing their certification in 1st Aid/CPR/AED.

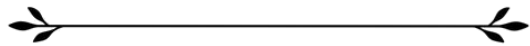


Mark your calendar...

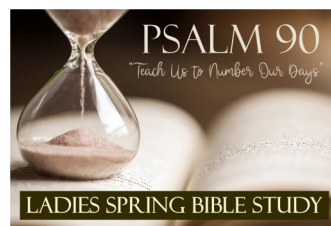
