Easy Apple Dumplings

1 stick butter
1 1/2 cups sugar
1 Tsp. cinnamon
2 tubes crescent rolls
4-5 apples
12 oz. Mountain Dew

Melt butter in pan. Add sugar and cinnamon. Stir to mix well. Set aside.

Place 1/4 apple in each crescent roll triangle and wrap. Place each into a baking dish that has been sprayed with cooking spray.

Cover each roll with the cinnamon-sugar-butter mixture.

Pour 12 oz. regular Mountain Dew or similar soda into baking dish. Do not pour on top to wash off the sugar mixture.

Bake in 350 degree oven for about 40 minutes or until rolls begin to brown.
