When I'm old and retired, when my hearing is gone and I don't move as quickly, I hope to bring children to VBS just like Brother Bob. VBS is as important now as ever. I believe it will be just as vital in the future. Every year, we all get VBS tired, but it's worth it. Every bit of it.

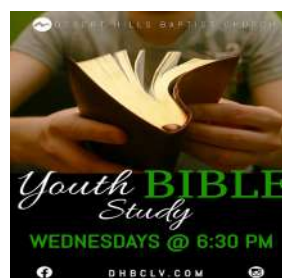
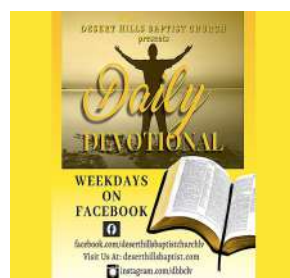
