### **Church Meetings App**

Remember that *Church Meetings* is the church management program we are using now to keep up with our membership information. It also has a **Church App** for our members that you can download from the Google or

Apple Store. There you can search for Church Meetings (the one with this graphic ). Then you can go through the prompts and set up your own personal account. (If you need more information to do this, contact the church office and we can walk you through the steps.)

From your ChMeetings App, you can do 2 things: 1) You can access our online directory. Here you can find cell numbers/addresses of our members. This is also where you can go to your own record, edit your information and add a picture of your choosing. (It would be real helpful if everyone would download the app and add a picture and update any of your information.) 2) You can access online giving – here you can set up recurring giving if you wish.




