

## STUDY QUESTIONS FROM JUDE

The Book of Jude is a powerful call for believers to *contend earnestly for the faith* and guard against false teachings.

### Verses 1-4

1. What does it mean to "contend earnestly for the faith" in today's society?
2. How can we identify false teachings in the modern world? (v.3)
3. What does "pervert the grace of our God" mean in modern contexts? (v.4)

### Verses 5-7

1. How does the reminder of the Exodus in Jude 1:5 serve as a warning for believers today? (v.5)
2. How can the dual nature of God as both deliverer and judge influence our daily walk with Him?
3. How does Jude 1:6 connect to Revelation 12:7-9?
4. How does Jude 1:7 warn against sexual immorality and unnatural desires today?
5. How does Jude 1:7 connect with Romans 1:26-27 on God's judgment?

### Verses 8-19

(Lead the discussion on verses 8-16)

1. How does Jude 1:18 connect with 2 Peter 3:2 regarding apostolic reminders?
2. How does Jude 1:19 connect with warnings in 2 Peter 2?

### Verses 20-23

1. What does "praying in the Holy Spirit" mean for our prayer life?
2. What role does "waiting for the mercy of our Lord" play in our faith?
3. What does Jude 1:22 mean by "show mercy to those who doubt"?
4. What is the meaning of verse 23?

### Verses 24-25

1. How does Jude 1:24 assure us of God's ability to keep us secure?
2. What actions can we take to honor God's "glory" in our daily lives?
