## family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

#### **SUMMARY:** MARK 7:24-37; 8:11-21

Jesus continued to travel, performing healings and miracles wherever He went. In these verses, He drove a demon out of a child and restored speech and hearing to a deaf and blind man. But these miraculous events weren't enough for the Pharisees, who asked Jesus for a sign from heaven. They failed to understand all the signs Jesus had already given them. Even the disciples didn't understand Him: they worried about food when they had already seen that Jesus was capable of providing more than anyone asked for. Jesus's compassion knows no bounds.

 $oldsymbol{01}$  Why didn't the Pharisees and disciples understand what Jesus was trying

**.02** How can you grow your faith that Jesus can and will meet your needs?

**PRAY:** Thank God for His compassion and His grace. Thank Him that He cared for people who were considered outcasts by their culture, and that He calls all people to be part of His family. Pray that He would grow your heart to love and serve others the way He does.
