family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

SUMMARY: MARK 10:32-45

Jesus and His disciples were heading into Jerusalem, and everything felt like it was changing. His followers were nervous and fearful—they knew that Jerusalem was the place where Jesus would face the Jewish and Roman leaders head-on, and they weren't sure what to expect. So Jesus told them exactly what to expect. But the disciples still weren't truly listening. James and John asked Jesus to seat them in the places of honor after He established His kingdom, and Jesus responded that they didn't know what they were asking for. If they truly wanted to be great, they would need to learn how to be servants.

discussion questions

.01 What were Jesus's disciples still misunderstanding?

What are some ways that you misunderstand Jesus? How do you misunderstand what it looks like to follow Him?

PRAY: Praise God for sending His Son to establish a kingdom where the least become the greatest and the downtrodden are blessed. Pray that you would see opportunities to serve the people around you this week and show them the love of Jesus.
