Read verses 37-42, then answer the following questions. Discuss as a group.

Peter, James, and John loved Jesus, and they knew He was upset. Why do you think they didn't stay awake to pray?

17 How did Jesus think prayer would help Peter avoid temptation? How did He know?

What do these verses teach us about the importance of prayer? How does prayer guard us against temptation and sin?
