.05 What two pieces of evidence did the angel offer that Jesus had risen? (See vv. 6-7.)

READ MARK 16:9-16,19-20.

Read verses 9-16 and 19-20, then answer the following questions. Discuss as a group.

Why do you think Mary didn't recognize Jesus at first? What might this tell us about her expectations?

.07 Why did Jesus rebuke disciples for their unbelief?

What did Jesus tell His disciples to do in His absence? What part does He continue to play in this process?
