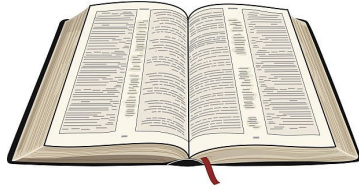

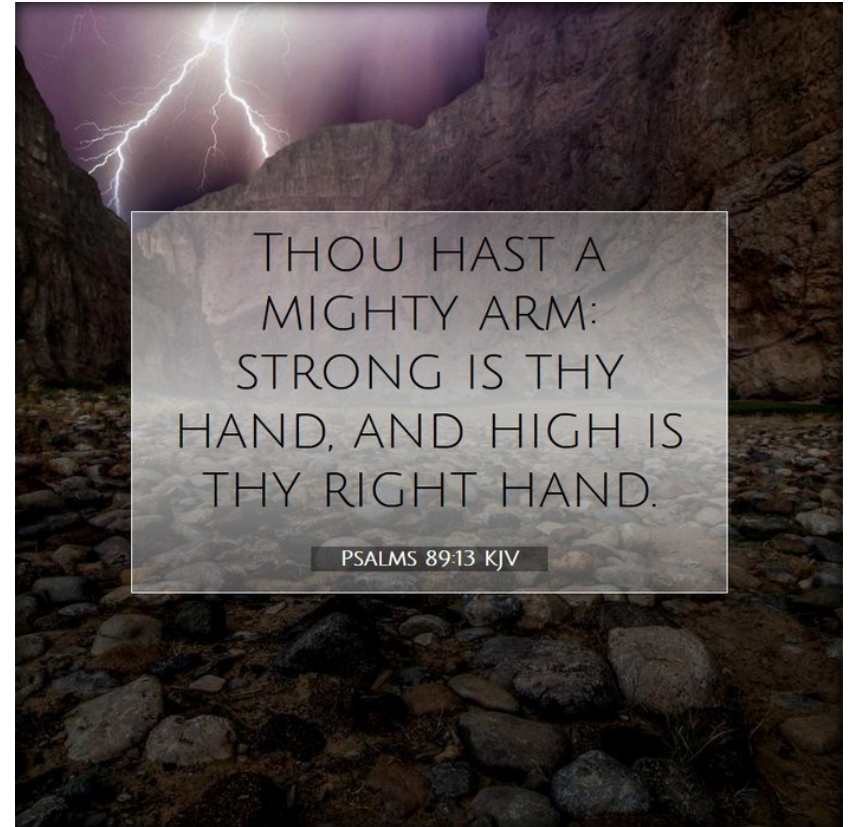

Build Deeper Relationships One Meal At A Time

Connections - Whether making new friends or digging deeper with old friends, meeting over a meal binds people in special ways. Many of us have great intentions to get together, to reach out, to be more inclusive. But sometimes our follow-through needs a little help! “Salt Shakers” allows opportunity to learn treasured stories of those dear saints who’ve passed on.
