

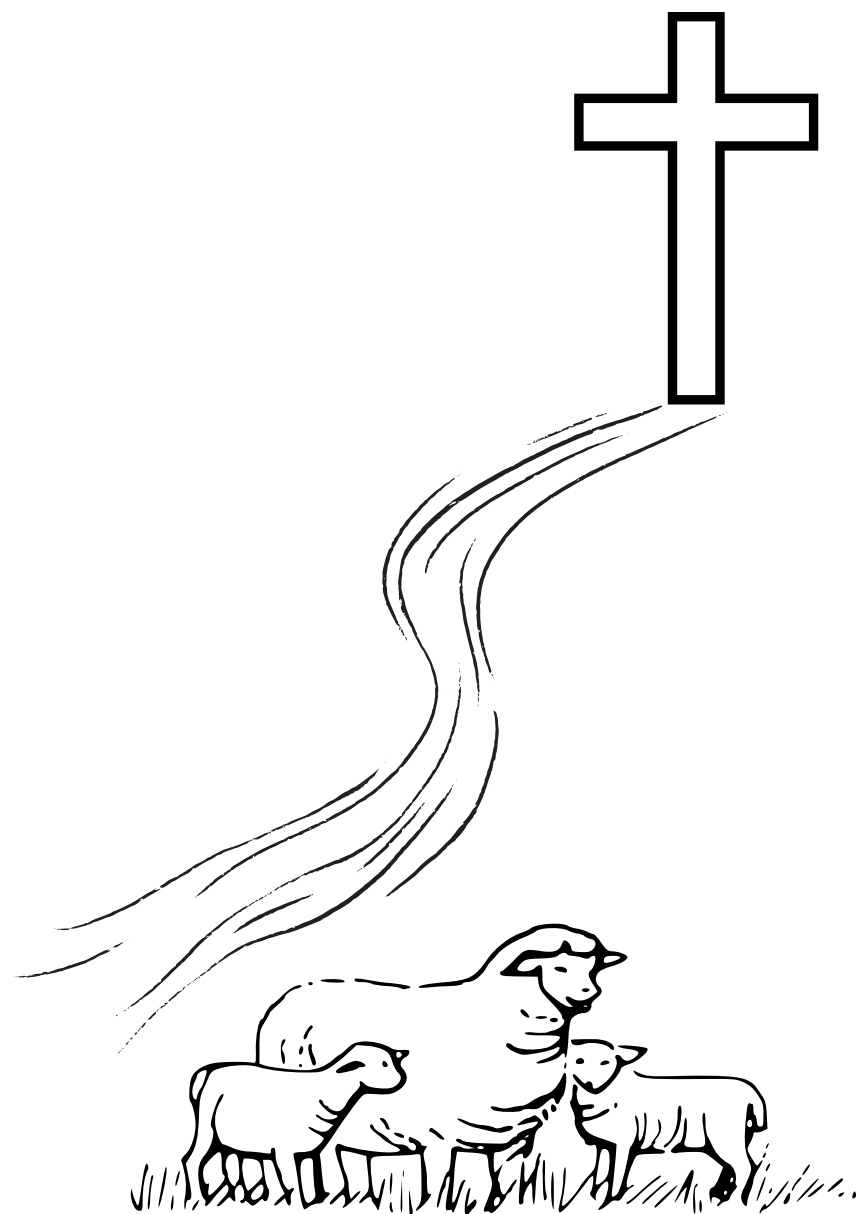
Announcements
